The *Cub Corner* magazine breaks the mold of worldly magazines. Within, there are stories about real Bible heroes: The *Summer 2009* issue taught the kids about Shamgar and his gallant stand against the Philistines. *Winter 2009* showed the sacrifice of Saint Martin, and Who he *really* gave half of

his coat to. *Spring 2010* had the Queen of Sheba crossing the parched desert to find King Solomon. These are the role models our children should have; and when the story is told, it is far greater than anything Spiderman or Star Wars could ever offer. It lets



them use their imaginations and play like all kids do, yet all the while, they are learning about the Word of God. But that is just a small part of this very special magazine.

Each issue has testimonies from believers in different parts of the world. Emma, from Argentina, told of how her neighbor's cat attacked her pet frog in the *Spring 2009* issue. The frog was killed, but the Lord answered little Emma's prayer and brought her pet back to life. The *Fall 2010* issue featured an article about a young Brazilian boy who gathered up every ounce of courage he had to show his teacher his *Mother Opossum* children's book. The teacher read it to the class and then showed it to her fellow teachers. Soon, the entire school was reading the book. Our young friend gave his prized possession to the school library, and his pastor donated another copy of the book so more of the students could read it.

When the *Cub Corner* kids get excited about their friends overseas, there is a way for them to save their pennies in their Jesus Jars and sponsor their own missionary work. Through the *Missionary Passport* program, they have sponsored Message material for believers in the Andes Mountains, food for believers devastated by typhoons in the Philippines, children's books that have gone around the world, megaphones for missionaries in Africa, and most recently, missionary work in the most remote islands of the Philippines. Every time they sponsor a work, they get a sticker to place in their Missionary Passport. The passport looks just like the real thing, except instead of getting stamps from visiting countries, they get stickers for spreading the Gospel.

The magazine is also packed with fun family activities. There are word searches, crossword puzzles, and challenging games that make for hours of enjoyment. The activities are not only entertaining, but they are also teaching the kids some very important lessons. They learn Bible facts, how to spell the names of Bible characters, and little-known details about Brother Branham. There is a *God's Creations* article in every issue, which teaches them about some interesting animals. There are even tear-out cards, titled "Heroes Of The Bible." Each hero card has a quote from Brother Branham as well as a Bible verse about a character that is pictured on the front.

Everything in the magazine points the reader to the Word, especially the *Quiz*. The challenge is to listen to a particular tape from Brother Branham and answer the questions listed in the magazine. This is serious for our young friends because they are listening to God's prophet. The kids listen to the tape while filling in the blanks, and then send their results to *Cub Corner*. Every time they take a quiz, they receive a coin imprinted with the featured character of that issue. We started with the



Queen of Sheba, and the most recent coin has a picture of one of the wise men that came from the East to worship Jesus. This has been a tremendous success. They don't want to miss a coin, so they carefully listen to Brother Branham's words to answer the questions, and then, with the help of mom or dad, send in their results. To add to this, the www.youngfoundations.org website

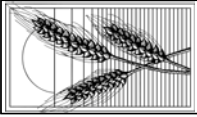
records the results of these quizzes and gives reward points. These points are added to those earned on the website from listening to Brother Branham's sermons. Later, the points can be redeemed for special gifts from Young Foundations. Of course, the greatest reward is hearing the Word, but the rewards that they earn will be something they can hold in their hand as a reminder of what the Lord Jesus is doing for them today.
